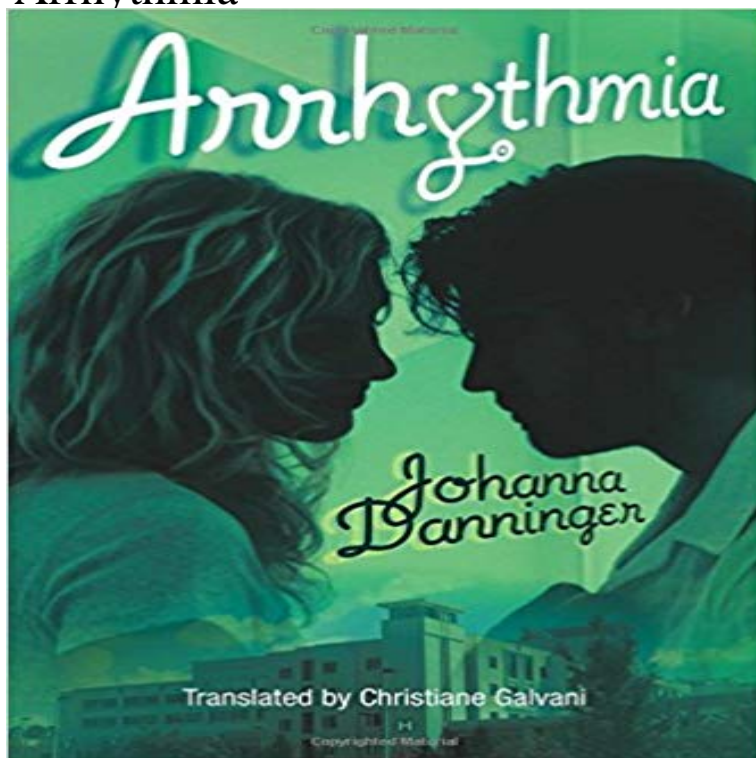


Arrhythmia
