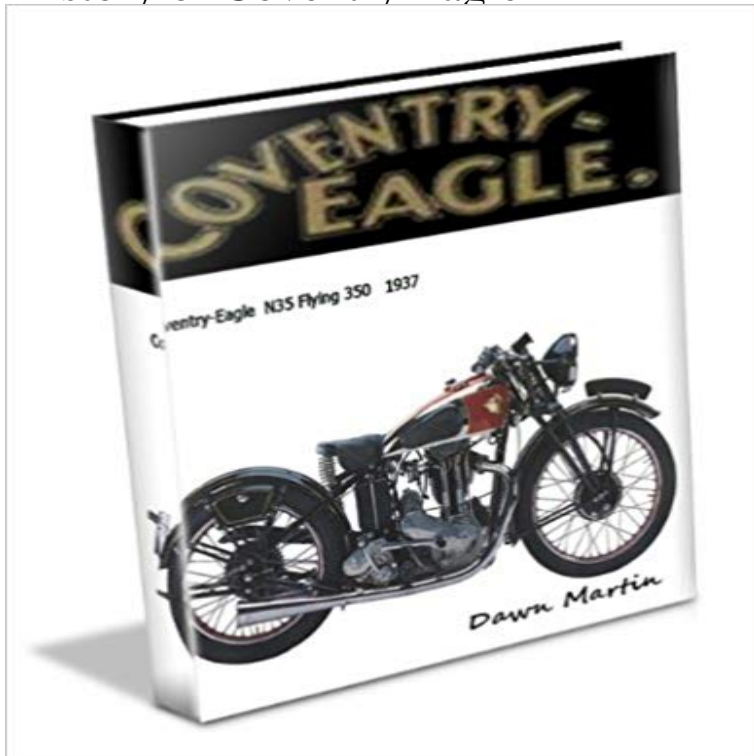


History of Coventry Eagle



Coventry Eagle began in 1890 as Hotchkiss, Mayo & Meek, but they changed their name to Coventry Eagle in 1897 when John Meek left the company. Their first cycle was the Royal Eagle safety model, but by 1898 they also began to experiment with motorised vehicles and by 1899, production of motorcycles had begun. The bikes were hand built and finished carefully, they also proved reliable and by World War 1, the range had expanded and included a Villiers powered two speed 269cc lightweight, a 3.5hp single, and a three speed 5hp V-twin.
