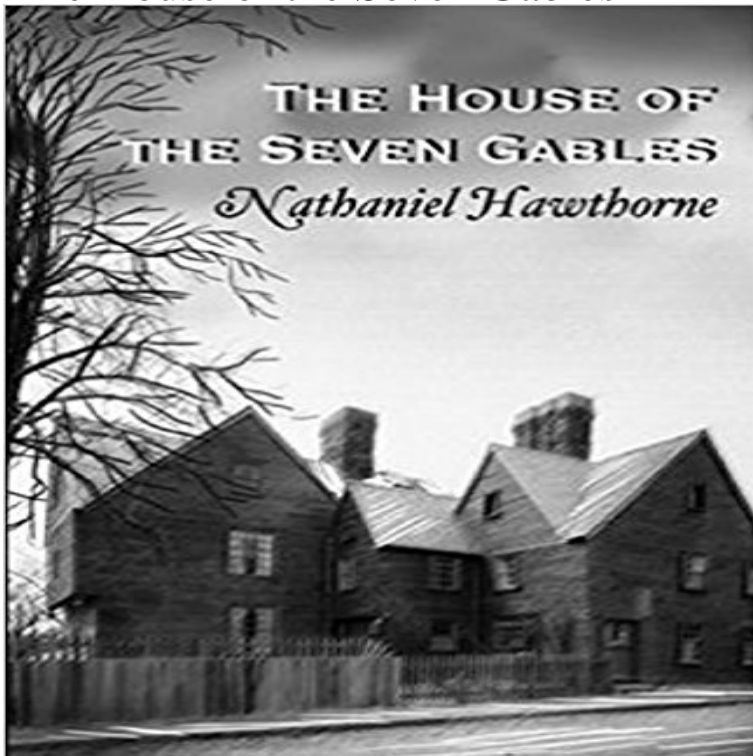


The House of the Seven Gables
