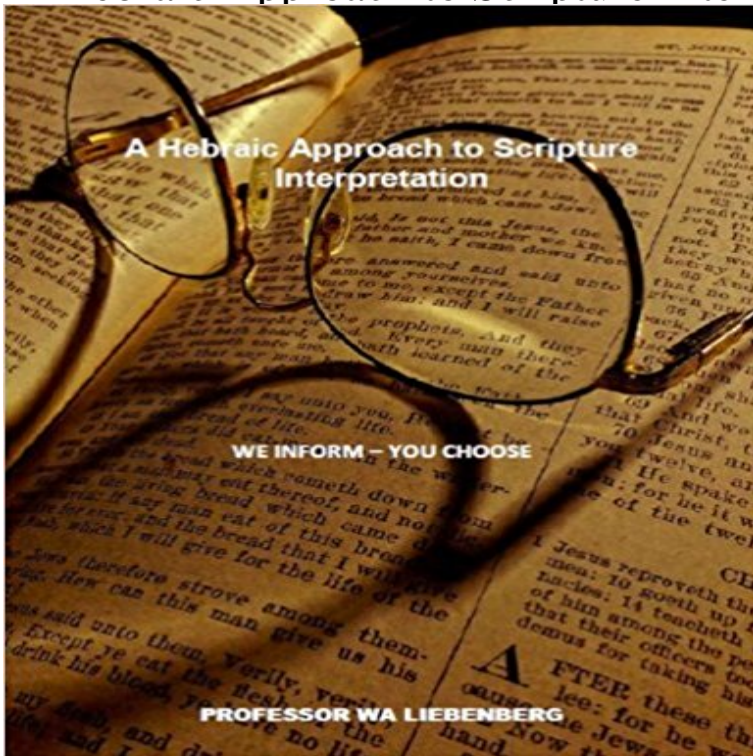


A Hebraic Approach to Scripture Interpretation
