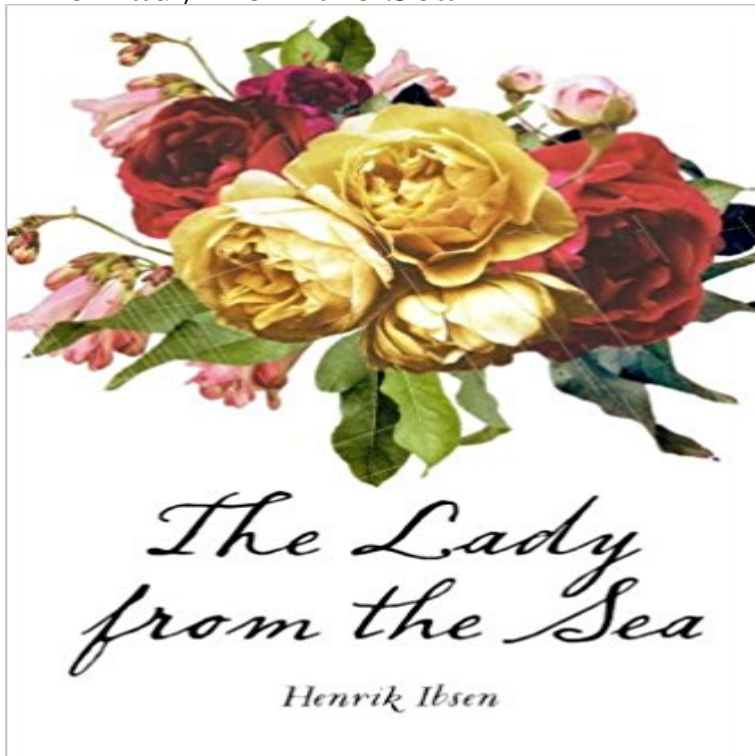


The Lady from the Sea



Henrik Ibsen (1828-1906) was a great 19th century Norwegian playwright who was considered one of the first prominent figures of modern theatre. Ibsen wrote many famous plays but none moreso than A Dolls House, which was controversial in its time for its criticism of 19th century marriages and morals yet remains the worlds most performed play today.
