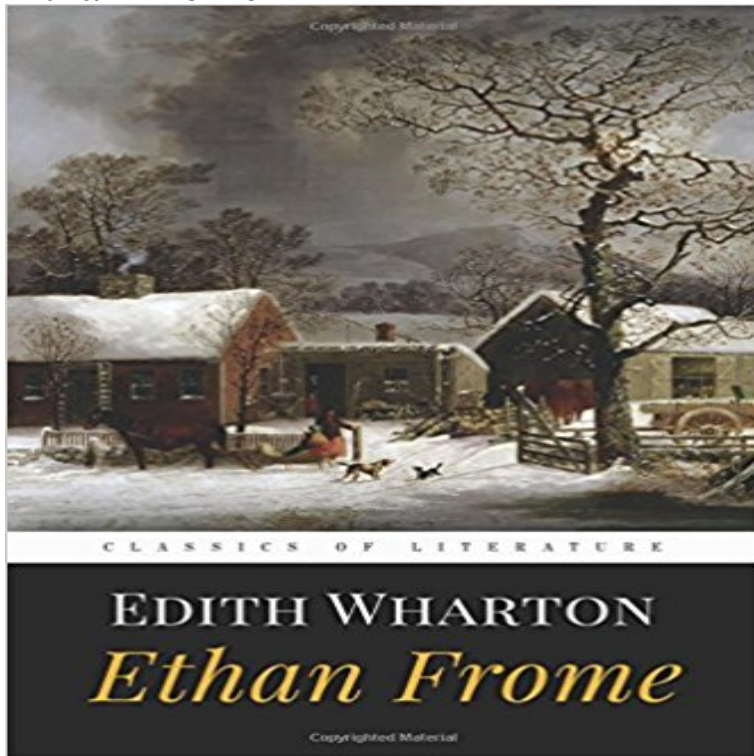


Ethan Frome
