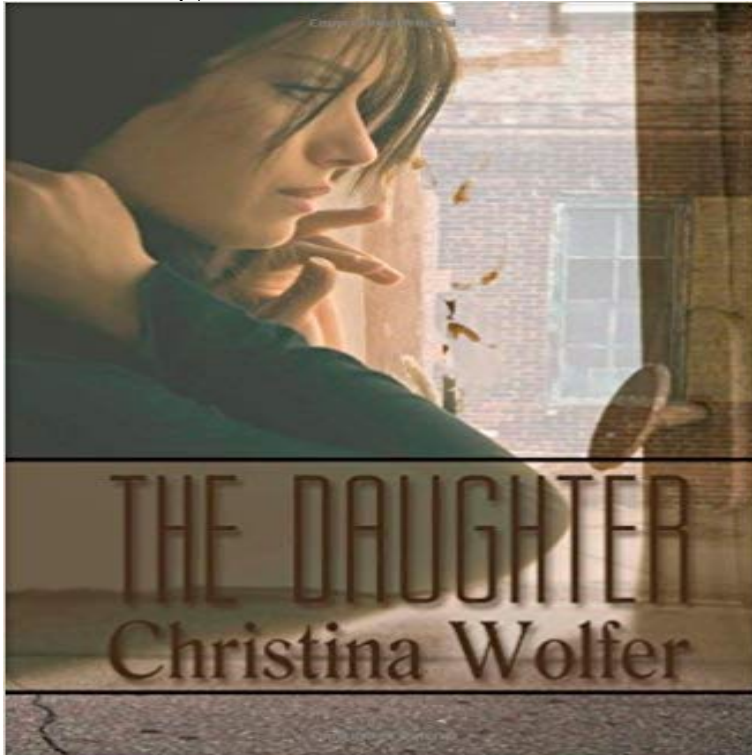


The Daughter
